aFRR CM mark-up methodology amendment

- The TSOs plan to send an amendment methodology as well as an explanatory document for public consultation during **April 2022**
- The TSOs plan to submit the amendment methodology to the NRAs at the latest **June 2022**
- The TSOs have agreed to make only minor changes to mark-up methodology – currently exploring guidance from the NRAs
- The TSOs have agreed make **no changes** to the different mark-up for different bidding zone borders, since this is already fulfilled in the existing methodology, where the dynamic mark-up will result in a differentiation between bidding zone borders from 1-5 EUR/MWh
- The efficiency of the forecasting methodology will be evaluated 3 month after go-live in accordance with article 12(5) of ACER decision
