



Overall go-live plan



- Go-live day: Tuesday 3rd of December
- Reserve go-live day: Tuesday 10th of December
- In the event of failure on these two dates → Replanning and a Tuesday after christmas.



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Go-live plan – the first MTU





- The timing of the go-live is adjusted from 10:00 CET to 13:00 CET based on feedback from some of the BSPs
- All integrations towards NOIS will continue to be available throughout the go-live period also after 11:15. The TSOs should strive to maintain the merit order list in NOIS throughout the go-live period to extent possible. This requires parallel bidding strategy from the BSPs. For BSPs that do not support parallel bidding, the TSO's must ensure that NOIS merit order list contains all available reserves for frequency balancing in the event of rollback.

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Rollback



- A rollback requires everyone to do a rollback.
- A rollback means to go back to manual frequency based balancing with the use of NOIS.
- A rollback shall be made within three hours from the decision is made.
- Point of no return is set to 13:00 CET on Thursday 5th of December.
- If major issues occur during the go-live, and before point-of-no-return where rollback is still an available option, the primary focus should be on roll-forward for all parties. A rollback should only be requested in a situation where operational security is impacted and where the agreed fallback procedures are not enough to solve the situation.
